Role of a LYB Professional

A Lean Yellow Belt Professional is expected to work under the Lean Manager or under Lean Executives. The Lean Yellow Belts will usually assist his or her senior in any, lean, process improvement, or any development projects. In many firms a LYB **Professional** will be hired as the **Lean Associate** or as the Junior Lean Executive as seen with the management structure illustrated below. Generally, any organization prefer this candidate to have;

- i. A Certificate, Diploma, or HND in, Engineering, Industrial Management, Operations or Business management, or in related field.
- ii. A Yellow Belt Level training in Lean Manufacturing or Process Improvement.
- iii. Some experience in assisting Lean activities is always advantageous, mostly experience is not required, and training will be provided.
- iv. Some knowledge about Production operations that is similar to what is seen in the factory.
- v. Knowledge about production machines, and equipment maintenance is advantageous.
- vi. Good team working skills, communication skills, and other soft skills are needed.

And it is recommended for **most** of the Supervisory or executive level roles in the production sector like the, Production Supervisor, Quality Supervisors and or Quality Executives, The Maintenance Supervisors and or Executives, Stores Executive, and for similar personals to complete any acceptable Lean Yellow Belt level training in Manufacturing.
